



## **JUNIOR LEADERSHIP LAWTON-FORT SILL 2025-2026 PROGRAM INFORMATION**

Junior Leadership Lawton Fort Sill class size will consist of no more than 20 students selected from the Lawton community. These slots will be dedicated to students who are currently in their junior year of high school. The program has been developed to foster individual student's leadership potential. Participants will be prepared for their leadership roles in society through education and practical training. Much training will be through seminars with community leaders and through team-building activities throughout the year. Participants are responsible for paying \$25 in tuition. If tuition is a barrier to participation, there are opportunities for scholarship. For details, contact the Junior Leadership Lawton-Fort Sill chairperson. Contact information is listed below.

The application process is as follows:

- Applications are due Monday, September 15, 2025.
- Applications will be delivered by email to your high school counselor or Activities Director.
- Once all applications are received, the selection committee will review the applicants and may schedule interviews, if necessary.
- Selected applicants will be notified no later than Monday, September 22, 2025.

If selected, students will be required to attend class activities on the following dates:

- October 22, 2025 - Orientation with parents
- November 5, 2025 - City Government Day
- December 3, 2025 - Education Day
- January 7, 2026 - Class Project Day
- February 4, 2026 - Mentorship Day
- March 4, 2026 - Fort Sill Day
- April TBD 2026 - State Capitol Day
- May 6, 2026 - Graduation Day
